3.0 PERSONAL INFORMATION. What we collect and why.

This website collects and uses personal information for the following reasons:

3.1 Site visitation tracking

This site uses Google Analytics (GA) to track user interaction. We use this data to find out how many people use the website and to track their journey through the website, how they find the information they need. This data is then used when we iterate and improve the website design.

Google Analytics records data such as your geographical location, device, internet browser and operating system. None of this information personally

identifies you. Google Analytics also records your computer's IP address which could be used to personally identify you, but Google do not grant us access to this. We consider Google to be a third-party data processor.

Google Analytics makes use of cookies, details of which can be found on [Google's developer guides](#).

The website uses the analytics.js implementation of Google Analytics, which means disabling cookies on your internet browser will stop Google Analytics from tracking any part of your visit to pages within this website.

3.2 Contact forms and email links

Should you choose to contact us using the contact form on our Contact us page or an email link like this one, none of the data that you supply will be stored by this website or passed to / be processed by any of the third party data processors defined in section 6.0. Instead the data will be collated into an email and sent to us over the [Simple Mail Transfer Protocol \(SMTP\)](#).

Our SMTP servers are protected by [TLS](#) (sometimes known as SSL) meaning that the email content is encrypted using [SHA-2](#), 256-bit cryptography before being sent across the internet. The email content is then decrypted by our local computers and devices.

4.0 HOW WE STORE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

The website does not store any personal information in its database.

5.0 ABOUT THIS WEBSITE'S SERVER

This website is hosted by Fallen Leaf Design LTD within a UK data centre located in Nottinghamshire.

All traffic (transferral of files) between this website and your browser is encrypted and delivered over [HTTPS](#).
